## To whom it may concern:

We, the Technical Division of Karmøy Island municipality, Norway, have received a request from Haugalandgruppen (LA4C) of NRRL. Their clubhouse is located at Holmen (Svendsholmen) in Åkrehamn, Karmøy, Norway. Upon their request, we are hereby able to confirm the following:

The total distance from the Norwegian mainland to Svendsholmen ( 6575350 North - 282150 East) measured at low tide is very accurately measured to be at least $\mathbf{2 5 9}$ meters. This as the result of three different crossings added together;

1. The distance under the Karmsund bridge; $\mathbf{1 7 6 . 9}$ meter. (From mainland Norway to Karmoy Island).
2. The distance of the man-made causeway from Åkrehamn (Aakre harbor) to Åkreøyna (Aakre Island); 51 meters.
3. The distance of the man-made causeway from Åkreøyna (Aakre island) to Svendsholmen; ca. 3 meters.

The crossings mentioned in \#2 and \#3 are man-made crossings for pedestrians and/or minimal road access to them. These are both made over canals where water still flows through under these man-made constructions (cf. IOTA rules C.3.2.).

It should be noted that even if the name Svendsholmen appears on publicly available maps, the small island is known as Holmen locally. (Holmen literally means 'small island').

Available public maps are hereby attached that shows the distances and scales.
