I am writing to you in reference to a letter I received from the Karmoy Kommune regarding a bicycle path, which is still in the planning process, and which effects my house in Norway, 412 Storasundvegen, in Torvastad.

My understanding is that the proposed bicycle path, will eliminate my stucco garden wall which separates my front yard from the road. This plan will also eliminate an iron gate and the paved area in front of it, which is the only place I can park to access my property.

I have 3 important requests that I am hoping could be taken under consideration by your office.

The first is if my garden wall is to be demolished, that it could be replaced with a natural stone wall, of approximately the same height as the one that I currently have and will lose to the bicycle path.

Second, With regard to the parking situation, I would like to have driveway access thru the bicycle path, to my house, preferably on the right side of my property, as when viewed from the street, the north side.

The third request, if I am losing the ability to park outside my gate, can a paved parking pad be made inside the wall on the north side.

This home has been in my family for over 50 years, and we try to go there as often as possible. We have family in the area that helps us to maintain it, and they are available for any questions or clarification you may need, and I can always be reached through email.

I am including a hand drawing of the property, and what we are hoping can be accommodated as well as a photo of the house.
